West dealer. Both sides vulnerable.

NORTH
 ♠ 7 4

The bidding:
 West North East South
 Pass 1♥ Pass 1♠
 Pass 2♥ Pass 2♠
 Pass 3NT Pass 4♠

Opening lead—king of hearts. This hand was played in a duplicate. The North-South pairs all got to four spades, but with varying results. Depending upon the defense and how declarer handled the trump situation, the contract was made or else defeated one trick.

Usually, the A-K of hearts were cashed, after which West shifted to a diamond. Declarer east playing low, and then went in dummy, led a spade, into a trance.

Those declarers who came out of the huddle and went up with the king and led another spade, crushing the A-Q together, made exactly four.
