SUMMERSIDE BUREAU OF THE GUARDIAN — Sentence was deferred for three months when five Miscouche youths appeared on charges of being in possession of stolen goods.

Lloyd David MacKinnon, Gordon Bernard Gallant, Joseph Gary Peters, Louis Joseph Poirier, and Joseph Clarence Campbell, were given the following conditions to comply with in that period of time: 1. to keep

the peace and be of good behaviour; 2. refrain for alcoholic beverages; 3. be at home not later than 12 midnight except for specific occasions when a written permission from their parents will be carried with them; and permission will be granted more than once a week; 4. the five are to appear to receive their sentence when called upon to do so.

All but one of the youths — aged 16 to 18 — admitted that they had drunk alcohol before.
