is not a single big summer hotel in this part of the province, but there is any number of exquisitely chosen, wholesome and comfortable little country inns where board may be obtained at very low rates. Indeed, the prices for guides, boats, teams, and board in this region are not much more than half of those which obtain in the more popular resorts.

Our living expenses for the whole time, not including the days on the sea, on the ocean, averaged 75 cents to each of us. Railroad steamship fares averaged 97 cents each. This \$172 was the whole actual cost per diem. Careful and detailed accounts of the expenses on our trip were made and preserved. These figures, showing rail road, steamer and living expenses, are not estimated, but are the actual results of our trip.

It is true that the post chaise now in use is not the sort of vehicle employed by the English Christians, who are to be believed, but it serves the same purpose and is probably far more comfortable.
