Chinese Termed Ingrates For Ignoring Soviet Aid

MOSCOW (AP)—The Russians have pictured the Chinese as ingrates who never would have won their revolution in 1949 without Soviet help.

The criticism Tuesday was another of a series of quarrels over whose theories of world revolution are the best. China accuses the Russians of abandoning "national liberation movements" and plotting for peace in Viet Nam.

Soviet historian A. M. Dubinsky, writing in the authoritative journal *Voprosy Istori* (Problems of History), denied Mao Tse-tung's theory that a revolutionary movement must depend entirely on local resources.

He said that in 1945 "the poorly-armed people's revolutionary army (of Mao's Communists) could not cope with" Japanese forces then occupying China and with U.S.-supported nationalist forces of Chiang Kai-shek.

"It was obvious that the Chinese people needed serious assistance," Dubinsky wrote. "They had only 'the Soviet Union to rely on.'"

INVASION A FACTOR
Contrary to Western historical evaluations, Dubinsky claimed that the Soviet invasion of Japanese-held Manchuria in the last days of the Pacific war had a decisive importance in Japan's surrender.

Mao's 8th Army in Manchuria was in an extremely difficult position when the Russians arrived, Dubinsky said, adding that the Red Army saved it and then routed the Japanese before the Chinese Communists could begin fighting.

"In the favorable conditions created by the victory of the Soviet armed forces," units of the 8th Army grew to 195,000
