Whoever so breaks the law, either "by himself, his clerk, servant or agent," is liable, for the first offence, to a fine of "not less than fifty dollars;" and for the second offence, "not less than one hundred dollars;" and for the third and every subsequent offence, the punishment is imprisonment "for a term not exceeding two months."
