**OLD BUILDING WILL HOUSE EARLY GRADES**

**Souris To Build School**

**Souris Council Favors Fast Time**

At a special meeting last night, the Souris Town Council went on record as favoring the establishment of fast time within the town, providing it could be done without an infringement of the uniform time act.

\*At a meeting of rate payers in Souris last night, decision was taken to build a four-room school to house grades 9, 10, 11 and 12, and to make extensive repairs and alterations to the present school to handle the lower grades. The present building was damaged by fire last month.

The vote was 50-41. Mr. Peter A. McIsaac was chairman. The meeting was one of the largest school meetings held in the town.

It is anticipated work will get underway on the new building shortly and it is hoped to have it ready for occupancy by mid-September.

A building committee was named last night, similar to a fact-finding committee named earlier. It is composed of the school trustees, John J. MacDonald, Roy Crockett and Alex T. MacDonald, together with Msgr. J. A. Murphy, E. L. Stewart, W. A. Acorn and J. M. McQuaid.

The site of the new school has not been decided. The meeting was held in St. Mary's Parish Hall.
