Grave Economic Problems Face New Prime Minister

LONDON (CP)—Grave economic problems face Prime Minister Harold Wilson as he begins his major job of trying to lead a new Britain by bringing segments of British industry under closer government control.

With Britain's trade gap widening and the prospect of the world becoming uneasy about a country under an estimated Britain's trade gap—the excess of imports over exports—has become a narrow strait. Former Manager Of CP Dies At 88

TORONTO (CP)—John A. McNeil, 88, general manager of The Canadian Press during 1939-45, died Sunday after a heart attack.

Mr. McNeil, managing editor of the Montreal Gazette for 12 years before he was appointed CP general manager, directed the affairs of the national newspaper in co-operation through the difficult years of the Second World War. He retired in 1945 for reasons of health.

Mr. McNeil never owned a car, yet he was interested in affairs of the Canadian Good Roads Association from its founding in Montreal in 1914. He attended some 30 of its annual meetings in the years and publicly representative.

Mr. McNeil's wife Grace died in 1954. He is survived by two sons, Marc T. of Ottawa and John Anthony of Toronto.
