1 cup butter  
1 cup white sugar  
1 cup milk  
2 cups flour  
1 1/2 cups baking powder  
1/2 lb. gum drops  
1/2 lb. raisins  
1/2 lb. cherries  
1-3 tsp. salt  
1 tsp. vanilla  
Beat oven 325 for 1 hour.

## CHIFFON CAKE

1/4 cups sifted cake flour  
1/2 cup sugar  
2 tsp. baking powder  
1/2 tsp. salt  
1/2 cup Mazola Oil

3 egg yolks  
1 tsp. vanilla  
1/2 cup cream of tartar  
3 egg whites  
Mix and sift first four ingredients, add Mazola oil, egg yolks and vanilla; add cream of tartar to egg whites in separate bowl. Fold egg whites into first mixture. Turn batter into ungreased 8 or 9-inch pan. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) about 1 hour or until cake springs back. Frost or serve as desired.

Prepare raisins day before or several hours by covering with cold water and bring to a boil, strain, spread out to dry slowly. Use 1/2 cup of the flour to sprinkle. Bake 1 1/2 - 2 hours in funnel pan at 375 deg. F.
