B. To be eligible applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. registered at either Holland College or University of Prince Edward Island;
2. enrolled in a full-time program;
3. out of school for at least two full years;
4. demonstrate financial need;
5. complete the Advisory Council's application form; and,
6. applications must be post-marked no later than October 15.

C. There are two awards from the Council with maximum of \$250.00 value amounts. One award is for a Holland College student and another award is for a UPEI student.

B. St. Andrew's Society bursaries are made available through endowment funds left to the Society for the promotion of Christian education of youth. To be eligible for a bursary, candidates must be: Catholic; a resident of PEI; have a Scottish surname or be at least 50 percent of Scottish origin; and, be a full-time university student. St. Andrew's bursaries are tenable for only the first two years of university.

After discussing the three main traditions of human rights, liberal, conservative, and socialist, he also said how these three traditions do not co-exist in harmony.

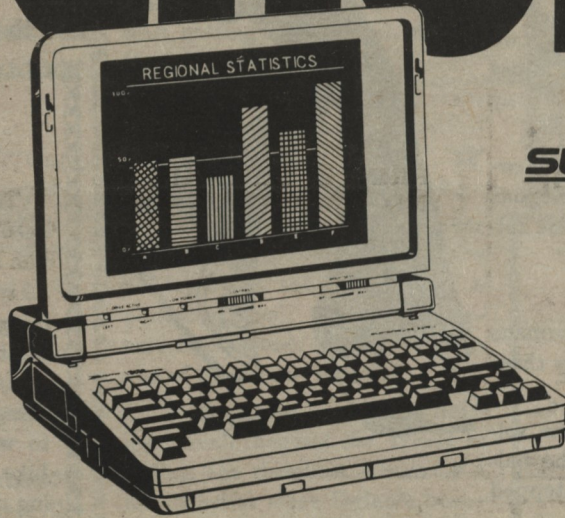
In the second part of his lecture, Dr. Baum gave a solution as to how these three traditions could live in harmony. In this solution he mentioned the human right to work, how full employ-
