## Military Funeral Set For Maj. Ivan Harper

Major Ivan J. Harper, MC, CD, died suddenly early Saturday morning in Charlottetown. He was 43.

Major Harper was second-in-command of the Prince Edward Island Regiment and had distinguished service as an armoured unit officer during the Second World War.

**WON MILITARY CROSS**  
He went overseas with the P.E.I. Light Horse and obtained his commission in England. He served in Italy with the 8th New Brunswick Hussars (RCAC) and won the Military Cross in that campaign. The decoration was presented after the war by Lord Alexander, then Governor General of Canada.

After the Italian campaign, his unit went to north-western Europe and was in Holland when the war ended. He had obtained the rank of Captain when hostilities ceased.

Major Harper joined the Department of Veterans Affairs after the war and was in charge of the treatment division in Charlottetown.

He is survived by his wife, the former Irene Judson, Pownal, and two sons, Dewar, with the Bank of Montreal in Halifax and Stephen, employed with P.E.I. Schurman Ltd. in Charlottetown.

Also surviving are one brother, Albert in North Carolina and two sisters, Margaret (Mrs. Frederick Coady), Southport, and Edith (Mrs. Arthur Clinton) Charlottetown. Another brother and his mother predeceased him several years ago, while his father passed away about a year ago.

Major Harper will be buried this afternoon with full military honors, with services being held at the First Baptist Church, Charlottetown.

## Former Lawyer In B.C. Dies Here

A prominent Vancouver lawyer, Arthur M. Whiteside, QC, died Friday, Nov. 30, in the P.E.I. Hospital after a lengthy illness.

Born in 1876, Mr. Whiteside was called to the British Columbia bar in 1897, practised law for 64 years until his retirement in 1961 and was president of the Vancouver Bar Association 1935-1936.

He was appointed King's Counsel in 1935 and was author of the B.C. Law Digest 1917-1933. He served as chancellor of the Ecological Province of B.C. (Anglican), and member of the board of trustees of the Canadian Theological College of B.C. He was also on the board of governors of the Victorian Order of Nurses.

He was honorary vice-president, B.C. Chamber of Mines; a member of the Union Club, Victoria, B.C., and life member and past master of Western Gorge Lodge, AF and AM, Vancouver, B.C.

He leaves to mourn two sons, Arthur and Richard, Vancouver and two daughters, Kathleen, Duncan, and Alan Holman, from whom service was conducted by Rev. 1961 - 62 to cover emergency costs resulting from the early spring snowstorms and potato crop losses. A surplus of \$18,400 was budgeted for the current fiscal year.

"If matters were normal there's no reason for wandering far from the estimated laid down in the annual budget," he said.

A few hours before the election was called Nov. 8, Provincial Treasurer Melvin Mecham announced sale of \$2,500,000 in 20-year bonds at par in the United States. He said, "the favorable interest par in the United States. He stressed financial position of the province."

With the month-long election campaign now in its final weeks, the tempo of canvassing, speech-making and party rallies has stepped up throughout the island.

Premier Shaw announced in a television address Saturday night that the province's third new food processing plant will be built in the immediate future in the western part of the island. He gave no details, however.

About 10 days ago he announced the government will build a \$10,000,000 frozen food plant at Montague in eastern P.E.I. to be operated by a British Columbia firm. He said the new plants will bring new opportunities for farmers to market their crops and for jobs in the plants themselves.
