Livestock

MONTREAL, June 27 (CP)—Receipts on Montreal livestock markets today were 141 cattle, 1,185 calves, 858 hogs and 150 sheep. 200 and lambs plus 6 cars reported. Veal calves were 25 to 50 cents higher. Other classes of livestock were steady. The cattle offered were mostly cows and bulls and prices were unchanged. Good cows sold up to \$5-50 with medium kinds from \$4-25 to \$5 and common butchers \$3-25 to \$4. Canners and cutters were \$2-50 to \$3-25. Common bulls were mostly \$4 to \$4-50. Good quality veals were \$7-25 to \$7-50 with tops up to \$8. Medium veals were \$6-50 to \$7 and fair kinds around \$6. Common veal calves were \$5-25 to \$5-75. Drinkers and light grassers were \$4 to \$4-75, mostly \$4-50 to \$4-75. Lambs were sold in mixed lots at \$9-50 to \$10, mostly \$10. Sheep were \$2-50 to \$3-50. Bacon hogs were \$9-75 to \$10 and fresh watered. Selects drew \$1 premium with the regular lots at off grades. Sows were \$5-50 to \$6. Hogs sold on rail grade brought \$13-35 to \$13-50 for bacon cold weight.

MONTREAL, June 27 (CP)—Butter and egg prices strengthened in brisk turnover on the Canadian commodity exchange today while cheese offerings traded irregularly. Butter spot: Que. (92 score) 21 1-2-5-8; Que. (88 score) 20 3-4-1-2. Sales: 400 Que. (92 score) 21 3-8; 700 Que. (92 score) 21 3-8; 300 Que. (92 score) 21 3-8; 700 Que. (92 score) 21 1-2. Cheese spot: Ontario white (June) 13-1-8a; Quebec white 12 3-8a; Quebec colored 12 1-2-3-16. Sales: 1,000 Queques \$9-75; 200 medium 20b; B-large 17b; C-15b. A slight weakness developed in poultry and cheese prices on open produce markets here today while butter and egg offerings held steady, the Dominion Department of Agriculture reported. Creamery butter prints to retailers sold for 22 3-4-73 cents a pound and solids for 22 1-4-1-2. Western butter delivered in Montreal was unquoted. Quebec No. 1 pasteurized in wholesale jobbing lots made 21 5-8. Ontario white cheese sold for 13 1-4 cents a pound and colored for 12 5-8 and colored for 12 3-4. Graded egg shipments in used free cases were offered at 23 cents a dozen for A-large, 20-21 for A-medium, 17 for B-large and 15 for C. Potatoes: N. B. and Maine No. 1 mts 80's 1-55-1-75; P. E. I.
