WINNIPEG, Aug. 3—(CP)—Aggressive buying of oats by American interests developed today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange.

Liberal offerings came into the market but they were well absorbed and all contract months of the commodity closed higher.

Barley was easier while late selling wiped out early gains in rye. Class two wheat, for export to countries other than the United Kingdom, was unchanged at \$2.06.

Export business totalling 2,100,000 bushels included 1,050,000 for the United Kingdom and 520,000 bushels for Belgium.
