

Dear Editor,

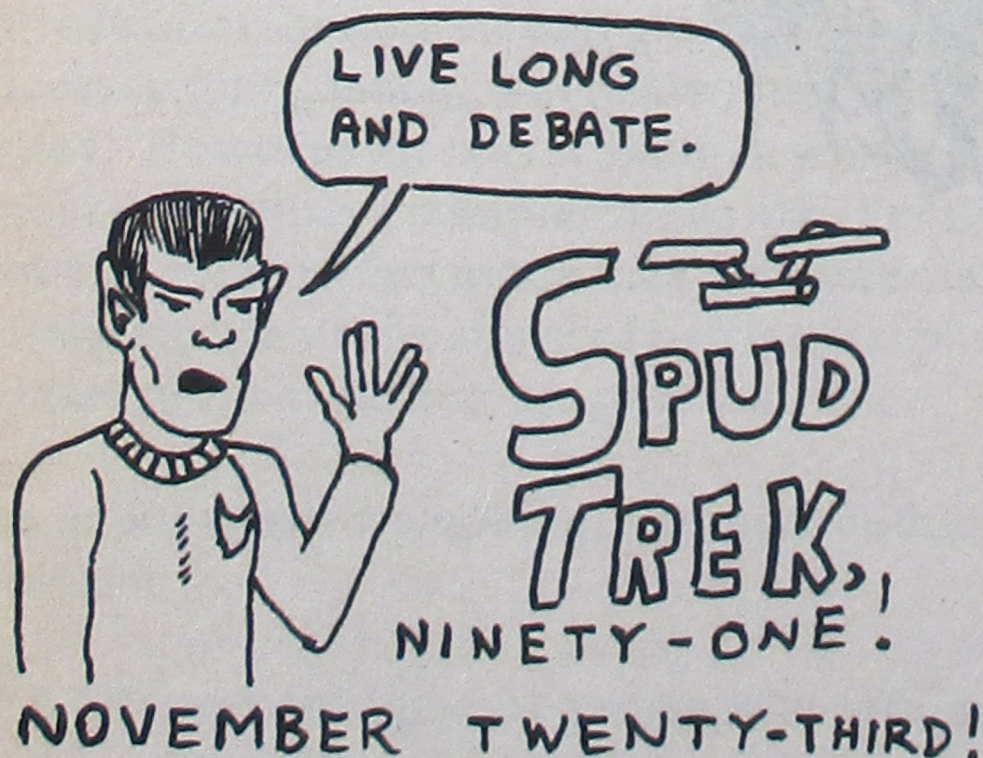
