Montreal Man Is Rated Highly As Actor In London

LONDON, (CP)—Paul Carpenter, a Montreal man who has dabbled in hockey, crooning and medical studies, may become one of the most versatile actors in London.

The French-speaking Canadian has just finished his biggest role in two years of busy film making. He has the lead in a movie called "Young Lovers," starring France's Odette Versois.

Carpenter, formerly Carpenter, admits that his stint in film-making has been both meteoric and more profitable than some of his previous jobs.

"It really is the best screen role I've had yet," said the 32-year-old in an interview.

Voices New Theory Re Planet Mars

ANN ARBOR, Mich., (AP)—The revolutionary "speculation" that the planet Mars may still be undergoing evolution towards "a habitable world" was advanced Monday by a University of Michigan astronomer.

Dr. Dean B. McLaughlin made it at a meeting of the American Astronomical Society.

He made it after first offering new explanations for certain dark areas on the red planet which hitherto have almost generally been considered to represent "vegetation—but vegetation on a planet which has more or less been considered to be a "dying" one.

Saying that these dark areas are explainable as drifts of volcanic ash deposited from erupting volcanoes in the Martian surface and influenced by prevailing summer winds, Dr. McLaughlin declared in his prepared report:

"These results challenge the view that Mars is an old, desiccating and dying planet. Perhaps it has not yet lived.

"The earth's oceans are thought to have developed through the accumulation of water brought from the interior by volcanism, and perhaps the formation of oceans belongs to the future of Mars.

"Instead of observing the death of a habitable world, perhaps we are witnessing the birth of one."

The scientist said that these quoted paragraphs were "highly speculative and should be considered as such." But he added that his reasoning with respect to the volcanic ash was to be considered as valid reasoning rather than mere speculation.

Red China Leader Leaves Conference For India Talks

GENEVA, (AP)—Red China's Chou En-lai, last of the big-name figures at the Geneva conference, will leave Wednesday for private talks with Prime Minister Nehru in India.

This was confirmed yesterday morning as representatives of the six non-Communist participants in the Indo-China peace talks met to review developments of the last few days and to consider their next steps.

Included in the meeting were the delegates of Britain, France, the United States, and the Indo-China states of Viet Nam, Laos and Cambodia.

DISCUSS PROBLEMS

They are understood to be preparing a proposal to set up a series of committees to take up specific problems, such as supervision of the proposed ceasefire, control of elections and guarantees against violation of agreements reached here.

By the time Chou leaves, direct military talks between the warring parties in Indo-China probably will have been arranged, and the major problem of halting the conflict will be in their hands.

An Indian plane left Bombay today to pick up Chou and his party. The group is scheduled to arrive in New Delhi Thursday.

KEY ROLE

The Chinese leader played an important role in week-end developments which steered the Indo-China talks toward direct negotiations. He was the principal architect of a formula, approved by the nine-party conference Saturday night, which called for such talks on the disputed kingdoms of Laos and Cambodia.

After the other chief diplomats left Sunday, Chou stayed on for private talks with representatives of Laos and Cambodia. Finally he brought them together Monday night with Pham Van Dong, vice-premier of the Communist-led Viet-minh rebels.

No information leaked out immediately from these talks, but the fact that representatives of the two kingdoms agreed to meet with the enemy was a radical departure from the early days of the conference when neither side would recognize the other.

22-Storey Office Building Erected In Record Time

NEW YORK, (AP)—Sixty-one workmen put up the aluminum walls of a 22-storey office building Monday in 9 1/2 hours, while hundreds of sidewalk superintendents gawked in amazement.

The thin, prefabricated sheets of aluminum, each one two stories high, were bolted into place at the rate of a storey every 23 minutes.

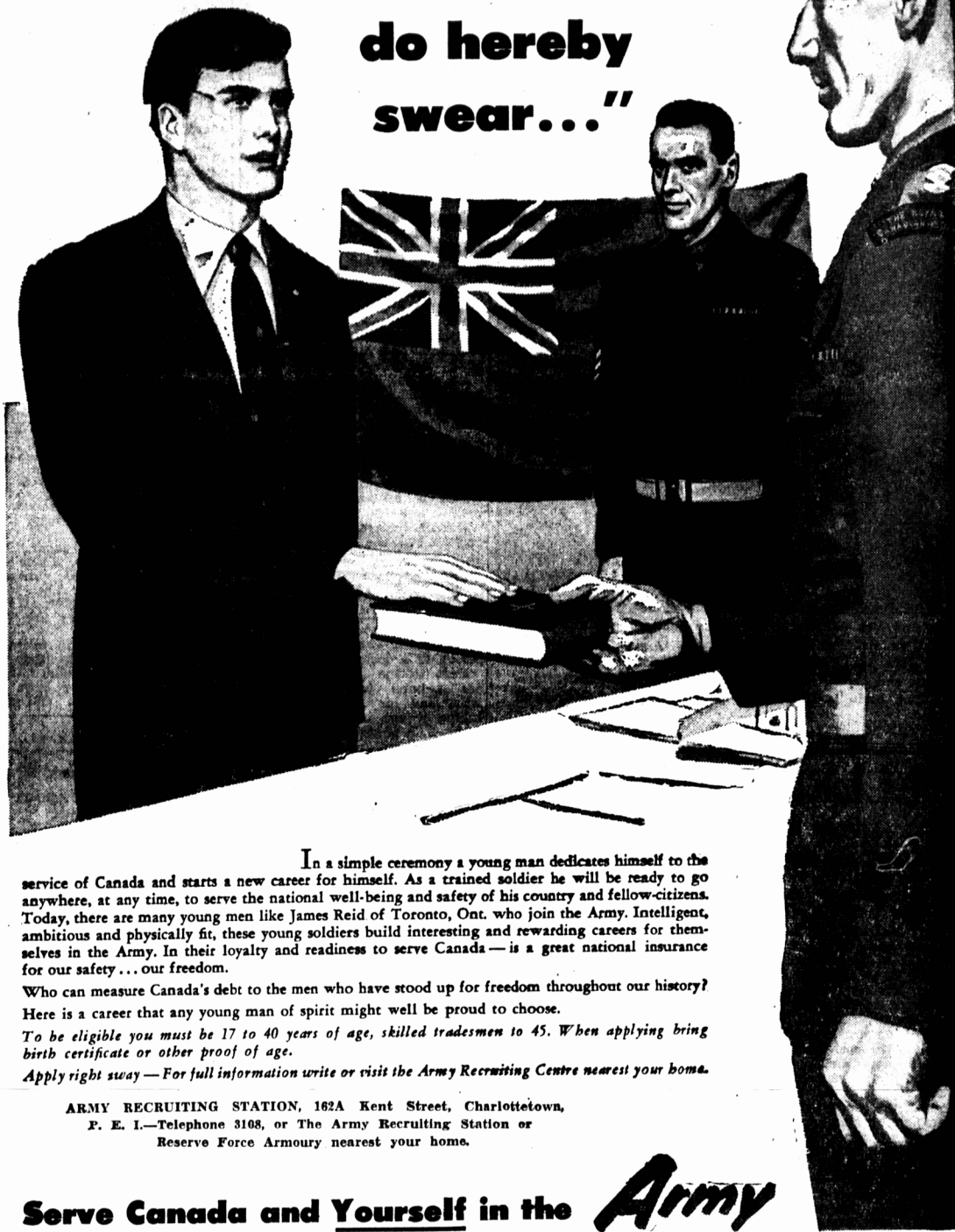
Norman Tishman, president of the realty company that is building the new structure at 57th street and Park avenue, said the job normally would have taken eight to 10 weeks.
