

How to Make Money.

The following statistics, gathered from reliable sources, are both interesting and instructive, and may be turned into money, so to speak, by farmers and poultry raisers.

It will be noticed that the average number of eggs laid per hen per year ranges from three dozen to over seven dozen and that those states which reported the largest number of eggs did not make the most money, because, as the figures above, they only got an average of four to five dozen eggs per hen per year, while the New England States showed an average of from six to over seven dozen.
