Temporary Trimming Is Noted In Canada's Trade Deficit

 OTTAWA (CP)—A midsummer surge in earnings from exports and tourism has trimmed Canada's international payments deficit for the first nine months of this year to \$280,000,000.

However, even as the bureau of statistics reported this improvement Tuesday it was believed forces were at work which will boost this year's fourth-quarter payments deficit much beyond last year's comparable \$121,000,000.

Among these factors are

higher dividend payments to foreign investors, a probable early-winter travel deficit, and especially a rise in imports touched off by the scheduled Jan. 1 increase to a full 11 per cent building materials. The tax apportionment from eight in the sales tax on production equipment and building materials. The tax applies to imports.

Net result, government economists believe, is likely to be a total 1964 payments deficit of approximately the same magnitude as in 1963. That deficit now has been revised to \$557,000,000 from the earlier estimate of \$521,000,000.

Even that, however, would be a big improvement from previous years when Canada had a string of huge international deficits on goods and services, reaching a peak of \$1,504,000,000 in 1959. It also would be below Finance Minister Gordon's forecast of a 1964 deficit of more than \$600,000,000.

Commodity trade figures, adjusted for balance of payments purposes, show an increase of more than \$1,000,000,000 to \$8,111,000,000 in exports compared with last year.
