—Machine-washing, ironing.

—Polishing silver, brass, copper, furniture, and mirrors.

The monthly schedule should include:

—Checking and arranging supplies on kitchen and bathroom shelves and cabinets.

—Waxing kitchen linoleum.

—Cleaning and straightening closets, drawers, vacuuming walls, washing and waxing blinds; washing curtains and lampshades that show soil.

—Washing windows.

The occasional (several times a year) schedule should include:

—Cleaning cabinets and relining drawers and shelves.

—Cleaning closets and chests; relining shelves and drawers.

—Laundering draperies and slipcovers.

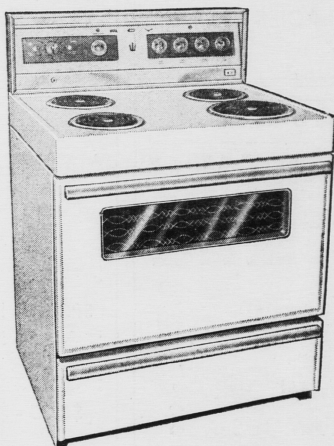
