today it is a real benefit to all farmers.

New Branches

In the Department of Agriculture today we have many new branches of service. The Veterinary Laboratory where all kinds of tests can be made on diseases of animals and poultry has done much to improve the health of our livestock.

"The fact that pullorum in chicks

has been practically stamped out is a striking example of the benefit of this laboratory.

"Another innovation in the Department of Agriculture is the placing of veterinarians in strategic points in the Province.

"We in Kings County will soon be able to get a veterinarian from Montague for a very reasonable fee.

"Time will not permit me to go into details on the activities of the different Departments. These details will be given by the Ministers in charge.

"Our Opposition friends criticize the Government for not spending enough in the Department of Agriculture but they lose sight of the fact that the very large expenditures that are made to improve the roads are really an assistance to Agriculture.

"Our present day system of farming and marketing demands improved roads and we are getting these improved roads as fast as the finances of the Province will allow.

"Mr. R. R. Bell, the new Leader of the Opposition, was reported in the press to have made the statement that the roads of the Province are no better now than they were in 1935. I can hardly believe that the responsible Leader of a Party would make such a statement.

been able to give, they are now paid considerably more than they received previous to 1943.

"By abolishing the Land and Road Tax, the Government made it possible for the School Districts to vote these larger supplements to teachers.

"Most farmers are now paying as much Land Tax as we ever paid, but we are paying it in the form of School Tax for the benefit of our teachers and schools rather than the Provincial Treasury.

"The policy of the Jones Government of assistance in the building of new schools and repairing old buildings has brought gratifying results. There is hardly a school district on the island that has not taken advantage of this plan and have either built new schools or repaired their old buildings. As we drive about the country, it is a pleasure to view these new and improved schools. Another great accomplishment of the Liberal Government is the establishment and operation of the Vocational School.

Here many practical courses are given in brick-laying, plastering, blacksmithing, motor mechanics, carpentry, agriculture and domestic science. It is regrettable that more of our young people from the rural districts do not take advantage of these courses.

Health And Welfare

"Another Department of the Government that has made phenomenal progress is the Department of Health and Welfare. It has now become the greatest spending Department of the Government. I would not attempt to explain the many different branches of this service to the people of the Province. It is sufficient to say that the administration of this Department has elicited the highest praise from the former Leader of the Opposition, Hon. Dr. W. J. P. MacMillan, a man that is very competent to judge in matters of health and welfare.

"The establishment of the new Department of Industry and Natural Resources was another step

forward by our energetic and progressive Government. Under this department is placed many important services to our fishermen and farmer.

"Here we have Land Drainage and Clearance, Electrical Inspection, Town Planning, Fish and Game Protection, Pest Control, Forestry, Trade, Potato Warehouses, Transportation, and the Fishermen's Loan Board. All these branches of the Department have rendered great service to the people and the Department is still growing.

"Quite lately a full time Director of Fisheries has been appointed, and now for the first time the fishermen have an official of the Government that is working exclusively in their interests.

"I have mentioned a few of the activities of our progressive Liberal Government. If you listen to the other Liberal speakers and platform, I think you will decide that the record of the Jones Government is a good one.

"Do you wish that Government to remain in office, to continue to govern our Province with initiative, vision and determination? Or do you wish to elect a government of the Conservative Party who can do nothing else than attempt to continue the policies of the Jones Government? Are you going to put

your trust in a leader that criticizes the Liberal Government for incurring some debt and then urges increased expenditure in many departments?

"There are only two ways he can increase expenditures without adding to the debt Mr. Bell would either have to increase taxes, or he would have to dispense with some of the services now being provided. What service is he going to discontinue?

"Think it over and I am sure you will decide to cast your ballots in favor of the Liberal candidates.
