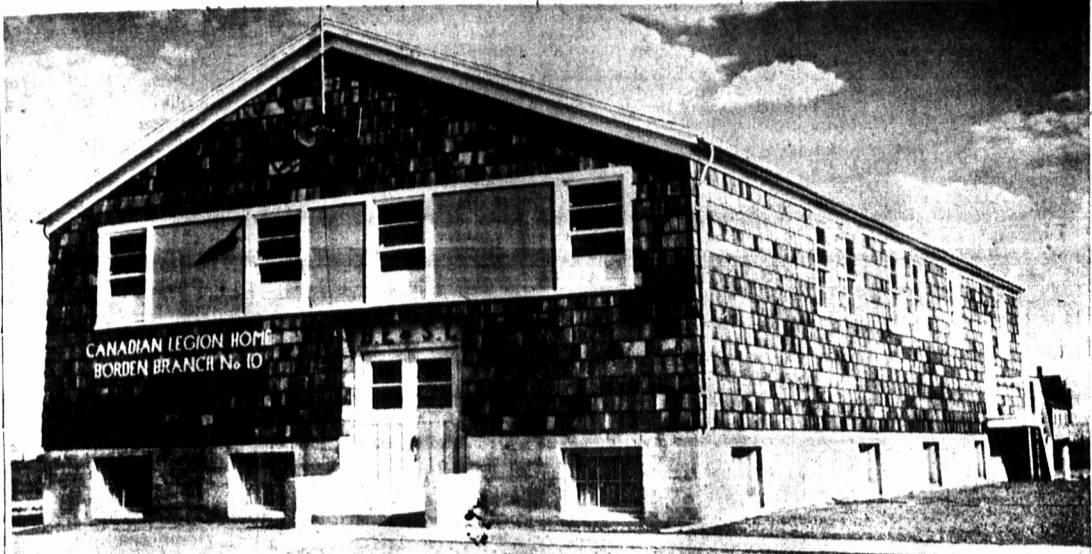


NEW BORDEN LEGION HOME OFFICIALLY OPENS TODAY

The new legion home at Borden above will be officially opened this afternoon presenting the members with an attractive, well designed building, 70 x 35, of two story dimensions.

The lower floor contains club rooms, lounges, offices and kitchen, while the upper floor provides a large auditorium, stage, dining room, cloak room, ticket office and canteen.

The exterior is of cedar shingles and constructed by local carpenters and legion members under the supervision of Ernest MacMillan of Ellerslie. The official ribbon cutting ceremony will be performed by the 1st vice-president William Murtart, chairman of the building committee, and an inspection of the building will be made by guests and the general public.

The Borden Branch of the Canadian Legion will officially open a beautiful new Legion Home tomorrow afternoon on a fitting program which will include the laying of the wreath by the Lieutenant Governor of the Province, The Hon. T.W.L. Prowse.

The ceremony will begin at 4 p.m. with the formation of a parade at the site of the Old Legion Home, which was destroyed by fire.

Lead by the Summerside Air Force Band the parade will proceed along the Trans-Canada Highway towards the R.C.M.P. barracks where the salute will be taken by Lieutenant Governor Prowse, then proceeding along the highway to the new Legion Home in the outer section of the town.

The parade will halt in front of the home where the band will take up a position at the right of the building. The ceremony at this point will include the playing of O Canada, the sounding of the Last Post, the observance of a two minute silence, Revielle, the reading by Lloyd Clarke, the laying of the wreath by the Lieutenant-Governor, and Poppies by veterans and Legion members. The names of fallen comrades from Borden and surrounding areas will be read by Lloyd Clark.

Remarks following the chairman's introduction will be made by Mayor Willard Leard, Lieutenant Governor T.W.L. Prowse, John A. MacDonald, representative of Dominion Command.

Following the dedication of the new home by the Branch padre, The official ribbon cutting ceremony will be performed by the 1st vice-president William Murtart, chairman of the building committee, and an inspection of the building will be made by guests and the general public.

During the month of April 1953 Provincial Command contacted past members regarding the re-grouping and re-opening of the Borden branch. A meeting was called and the officers elected were: president, Jack McIsaac, secretary-treasurer, Emery Richard.

The Branch started off with approximately 20 members in the Legion building opposite the skating rink and there has been a steady increase of membership since that date.

The Legion activities are many and varied. Donations to charitable organizations, Christmas parties for the children and Christmas boxes given out to the needy. An artificial leg was given to a local boy who quickly adapted himself to it. In winter months the ice rink has been operated by the Legion each year since 1953.

In 1954 it was found that a new home was needed and plans were proposed for its construction. Then in May 1955, the Legion Home was lost by fire. The building and furnishings were completely destroyed with only about \$1,000 insurance of the loss. This set back was overcome by renting and renovating the building that once had been the old drug store. Furnishings were loaned and branch activities, continued.

In this same month, May 1955, the ground was broken for the new home and carpenters assist-

ed by legion members were soon at work and the building was ready for use. This new legion home is a wooden structure 70x 35 feet resting on a cement base. It has two floors, the lower floor being given over to club rooms, two lounges office, kitchen, and boiler room all finishes in gyp-rock and plywood.

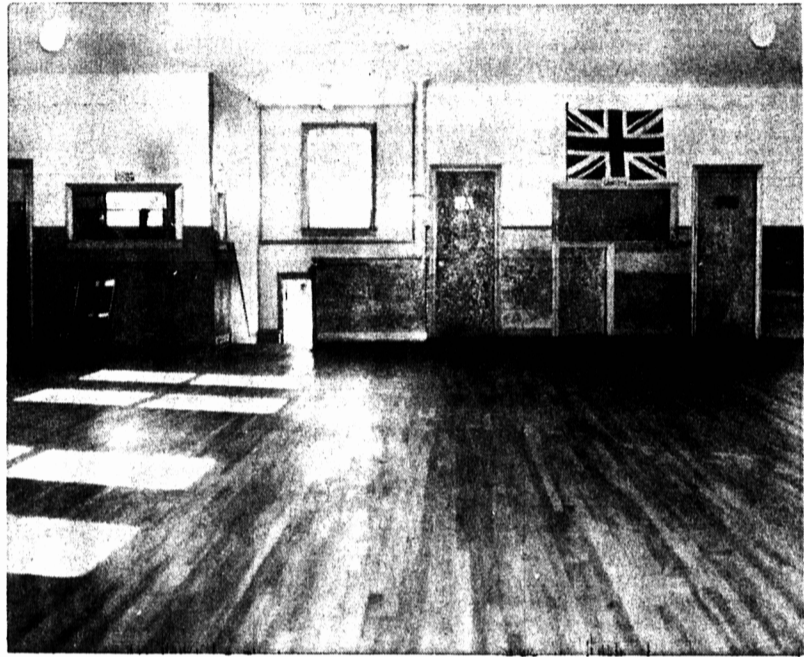
