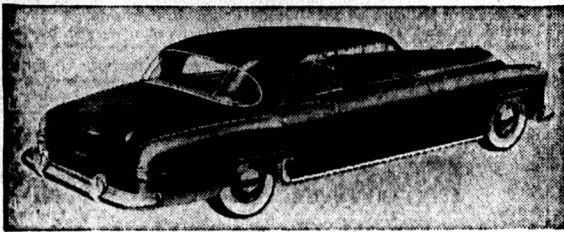


### 1952 PLYMOUTH BELVEDERE
