REGINA (CP) — A multi-million-dollar program of oil exploration and development in a comparatively small area in southeastern Saskatchewan is swinging into high gear as oil companies report amazing successes. Out of 26 wells drilled in the Estevan district, 125 miles southeast of Regina, only 25 have been abandoned as failures. The oil industry has set a 1956 target of 500 wells for the area.
