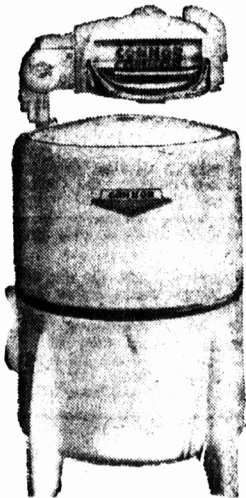

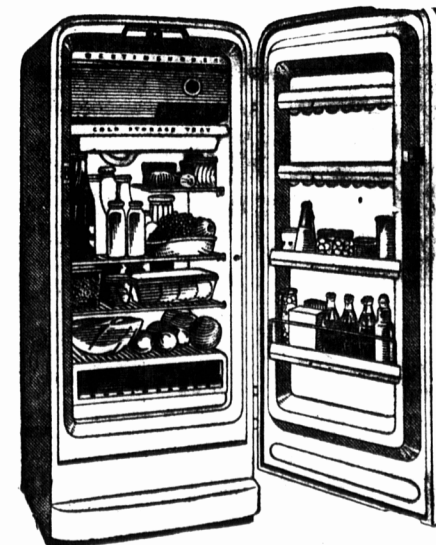

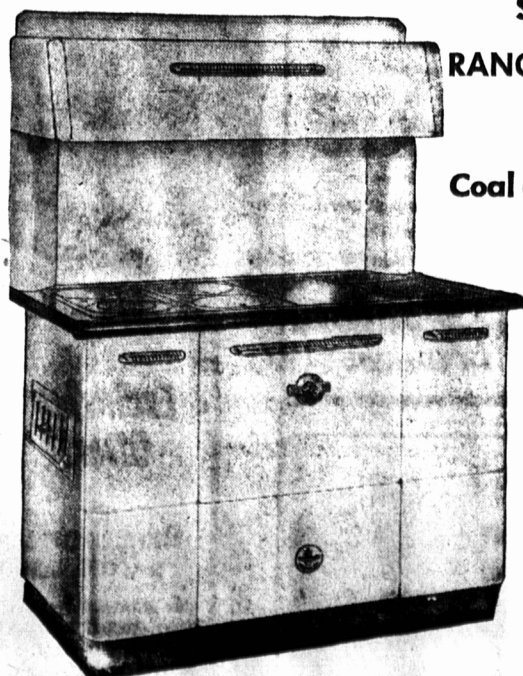

That Amazing Fighter Rugged Bob Fitzsimmons

Sir.—Bob Fitzsimmons was thought by some to be the greatest fighter, pound for pound, that ever lived. He was born in Cornwall, England, June 4, 1862, and began boxing in amateur ranks in 1880. After winning the New Zealand title he journeyed the U. S. in 1890 and was so impressive in winning his first bout he was offered a chance at the middleweight title held by Jack (Non-Pariel) Dempsey.

Fitzsimmons knocked out Dempsey in 13 rounds and then ran up a long string of K.O.'s including a terrible beating to Jim Hall, an Australian who had previously beaten Fitzsimmons before Bob left for the U.S.

On November 19, 1894 his career almost came to an end when his opponent in a bout, Cal Roridan, collapsed after two rounds and an hour later died. Fitzsimmons was cleared of all responsibility by an investigating committee and convinced by his friends that it was folly to blame himself for Roridan's death he returned to the ring.

Fitzsimmons pressed for a chance at the heavyweight crown held at the time by Gentleman Jim Corbett. In order to add weight to his demands Bob took on Peter Mahar twice and administered a terrific beating to an up and coming young heavyweight "Sailor" Tom Sharkey before fouling out in the eighth round.

Fitzsimmons was given a his chance at the heavyweight title and Carson City was selected as the site of the bout to take place on St. Patrick's Day 1897. Corbett was a 4-1 favorite and had all the advantages. At 183 he weighed 26 pounds over Fitz and the age of 35 had a 6-year edge in years, Fitzsimmons being 35.

The bout was a classic of the ring if only because Fitzsimmons introduced a blow later dubbed by sports-writers as the "solar plexus" punch. It was with this blow that Fitzsimmons chilled Corbett in the 14th round and became the heavyweight champion of the world.

It was a good workout for the champion who weighed 194½ and must shed 20 pounds before his title fight with Yolande Pompey June 8 in London.

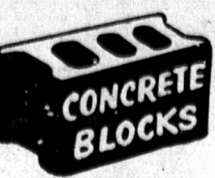
