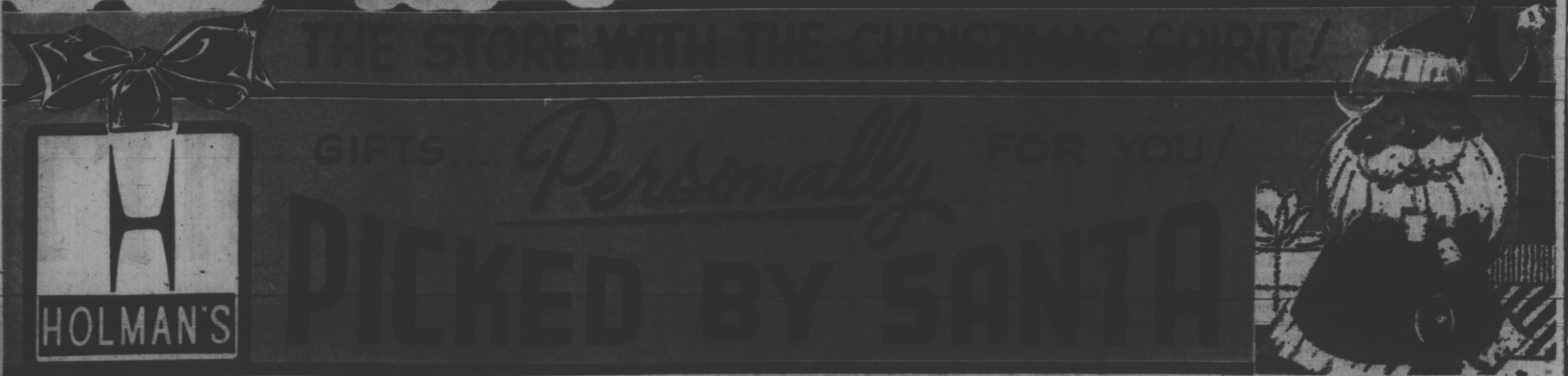

Millionaire Voted Mayor Of Vancouver

VANCOUVER (CP) — Tom Campbell, a brash 32-year-old real estate developer with a flair for controversy, won the mayoralty of Canada's third largest city by a razor-thin margin.

Mr. Campbell, a fast-talking millionaire whose pollsters underestimated, defeated incumbent William Rathie by little more than 1,200 votes in Wednesday's civic election.

He polled 41,073 votes to Mayor Rathie's 39,948 in one of the closest election battles in the city's history.

Socialist candidate Joan Randa, the only other mayoralty candidate, drew 6,534 votes, also a big surprise to election experts, who estimated the 21-year-old magazine editor had little hope of reaching the 1,000 mark.

Mr. Campbell said he is "going to try and be one of Vancouver's better mayors."

Mr. Campbell also promised to stir up a fuss by releasing a confidential report prepared last year by lawyer George Murray on alleged criminal activities by some Vancouver police officers.

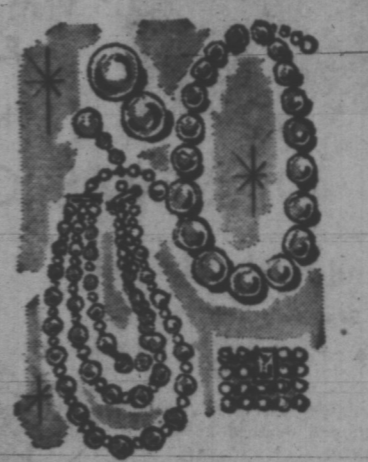

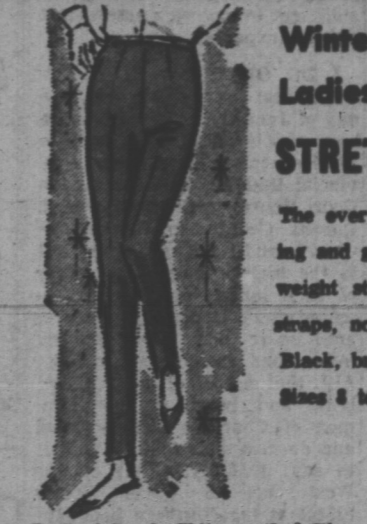
