Praise Better Homes Effort

FREDERICTON, N.B. (CP) — Federal Labor Minister Starr gave a pat on the back to operation home improvement (Frederiction, Canada's first full scale fix-up promotion, dedicated to "better homes—a better city."

"I am keenly interested in the development of your campaign in Frederiction and the labor minister. I congratulate you on the initiative shown in organizing this campaign and I hope that the results achieved will more than come up to your expectations."

The Frederiction campaign is designed to stimulate interest in remodeling and renovating during the winter months and to familiarize homeowners with the home improvement loans available at local banks for this work.

"Although we have made good progress in the construction of new housing since the war, the improvement of the older homes has not developed as rapidly," said Mr. Starr.

PRESERVE OLD HOMES

"The need for maintaining and preserving the fine old homes in Canada is well recognized. It is very much worth doing on its own merits, but the aspect of operation home improvement which is primarily concerned with the minister of labor is the employment aspect."

"For many years now we have had in Canada a problem known as seasonal unemployment. This problem is created when an industry either slows down or closes down during the winter months."

"Often this slowdown is the result of cold weather, but we have found that much of it is caused by our habits and traditions."

"We must get to work on this problem. We must bring our thinking up to date and make use of all the modern technological improvements which have made the conduct of winter operations in a wide variety of trades and industries not only feasible but skilled more and the materials for home improvement operations are much more readily available in the winter months than they are in the summer when outside construction is at its peak."

Says Israel Time Bomb

TORONTO (CP) — An American news agency said Monday Israel is the time bomb of the Middle East.

Ruth Gruber, special foreign correspondent of the New York Herald Tribune, said Israel is the testing ground for East and West conflict.

Moreover, she told the 17th biennial convention of the Hadassah Organization of Canada, Buxton is firmly entrenched in the Middle East.

"There is no Salk vaccine against the paralysis of communism. The uneasy marriage between Russia and Egypt may mean the end of Western civilization and Christianity."

"It is ironic that the little Jewish state of Israel may be the one nation to save Christianity in the Middle East."
