

## Expect Conservatives To Dwell On Organization

OTTAWA, (CP)—Organization rather than party leadership is expected to be the chief behind-the-scenes pre-occupation of Progressive Conservative workers in the next six months.

Hon. George Drew is reported to have the solid backing of his 40 followers who form the official Opposition he will lead in the House of Commons which resumes sittings next Nov. 12.

The party is to hold its national meeting next spring, probably in late March or early April. That will not be a convention but it is certain the question of leadership will be discussed then. At the moment the indications are that Mr. Drew will get a vote of confidence and the party will concentrate on the task of organization for the next general election.

The annual meeting of the national organization was not held in 1953. In the spring the party was faced with not only the Coronation which took Mr. Drew and many of its prominent members to London, but also with a general election.

There was some talk and some difference of opinion about holding the deferred meeting after

the general election but it was put off until next spring.

**Nowlan May Resign**

George C. Nowlan, member-elect for Digby-Annapolis-Kings, and national president for over two years the normal term of office of the Progressive Conservative Association probably will retire from the presidency.

The fight for the national presidency—if there is a contest—probably will be between George Hees, 43, member-elect for Toronto-Broadview, and Murdo MacPherson, Regina lawyer, former Saskatchewan attorney general and long time party stalwart in the West.

Progress of fresh organizational efforts and their success in the next year or two probably will have a bearing on whether or not a convention will be called before the next general election, which may not come before 1957.

Meanwhile the indications here are that Mr. Drew will continue as party leader and attempt to create a national organization that will prepare the rank and file for an all out effort when the next election comes.

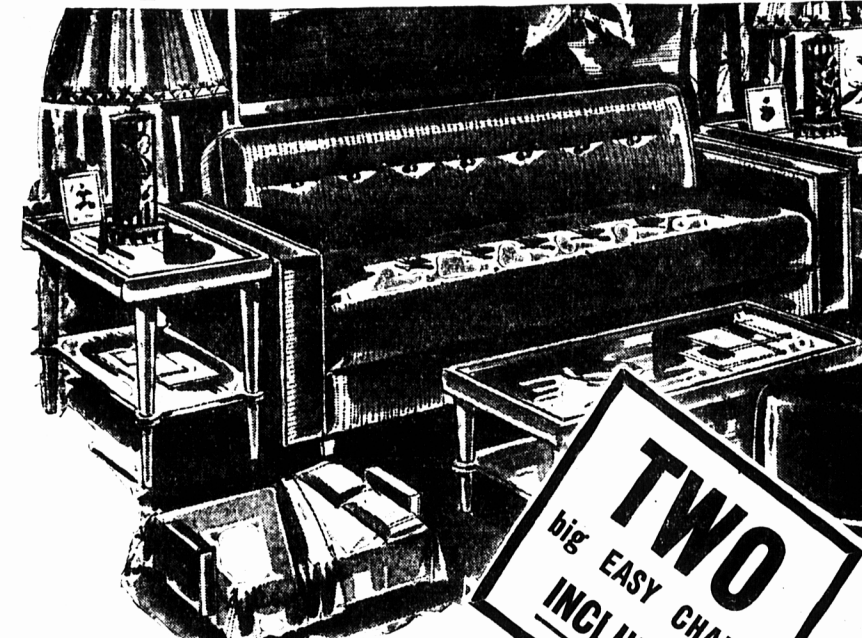




