REDUCE PEACE FORCE
NICOSIA, Cyprus (Reuters)—The 600-man Irish contingent serving with the United Nations peace force in Cyprus will not be replaced when it completes its tour of duty later this month a United Nations spokesman said Saturday. The withdrawal of the Irish contingent will reduce the force to little more than 5,000 troops and civilian police supplied by Britain, Canada, Austria, Denmark, Finland, Sweden, Australia and New Zealand.
