Toronto Stocks

TORONTO (CP) — Industrials advanced for the year on the stock exchange Friday. Producer mines and near-producers had a good day with gains up to \$3.

But total volume was low at 7,071,000 shares. Western oils advanced in a late rally.

Shawinigan headed the industrial winners with a 4 1/2 gain. Canadian Locomotive advanced \$3 and Imperial Oil climbed \$2.75.

Mountain was up \$1.25. Aluminum, Pembina and Minnesota and Ontario posted 2 1/2 gains. Steels were up \$2.25.

Off a point were Eddy, Great Lakes Paper, Powell River, Toronto-Dominion Bank, Imperial Oil, Glace and International Metal A.

Coast Copper led advancing mines with a \$3 jump. International Nickel was up \$2.37 and Hudson Bay up 87 cents.

Index gains: Industrials 5.48 to 472.56, golds .68 to 88.80, base metals .48 to 245.78 and western oils 1.08 to 154.75.

British Columbia, like its sister institutions in Alberta and Saskatchewan, Dr. L.S. Kinck, from Macdonald College, Quebec, was the first Dean of Agriculture and Professor of Agronomy, from 1914 to 1919, when he succeeded Dr. F.F. Wesbrook as President of the University.

The faculty originally was established with five departments — Animal Husbandry, Agronomy, Dairying, Horticulture and Poultry Husbandry; there have since been added departments of Agricultural Economics, Agricultural Mechanics and Soil Science.
