RESIGNATION OF THE GOVERNMENT.

Perhaps To-Day--Probably To-Morrow. Forecast of the New Ministry.

OTTAWA, July 7. The day of Laurier's advent to office is approaching. I asked the Premier last evening when the ministry were likely to resign and his reply was, "The day is not very remote."

Sir Charles is naturally somewhat uncommunicative on the subject, as official etiquette requires that the Governor-General should be the first to receive news of the Premier's intention of his desire to step out.

The resignation may take place to-day, but it is more likely to be on Wednesday. As soon as the Liberal leader gets an invitation to call on the Governor-General, he will do so and will immediately assume the task of forming a ministry.

MONTREAL, July 7. Up to the present Mr. Laurier has kept his friends in darkness as to the state that was prepared here last week, but the following is quite probable: Premier and President of the Council, Mr. Laurier; Minister of Justice, Sir Oliver Mowat; Minister of Finance, Sir Richard Cartwright; Minister of Railways and Canals, Hon. Mr. Davies; Postmaster-General, Hon. David Miller; Minister of Public Works, Hon. W. S. Fielding; Minister of Militia, Hon. Mr. Blair; Minister of Marine and Fisheries, Hon. D. C. Fraser; Secretary of State, Hon. Mr. Tarte; Minister of Agriculture, Hon. Sidney Fisher; Controller of Customs, Hon. W. Mulock; Solicitor-General, Hon. C. Fitzpatrick; without portfolio, Hon. C. A. Geoffrion and a member from British Columbia.

There is some doubt as to who will get the portfolio of the Interior, but it will go to a Westerner—probably Hon. Mr. Sifton or Joseph Martin, if a seat can be arranged for him. In the meantime, it may be filled temporarily by another.

Mr. J. D. Edgar is put down for Speaker, with L. P. Brodeur as Deputy, and Senator Pelletier as Speaker of the Senate. Hon. R. W. Scott will be Leader in the Senate for a time, with a seat in the Cabinet without portfolio.

A DISGRACEFUL ROW IN A HOTEL.

A Banker's Agent In It. Fatal Result Feared.

NEWCASTLE, N. B., July 7. John McKean, Agent of the Merchants Bank of Halifax at Newcastle, and Norman McKean, druggist, were at the Waverley Hotel at 4 o'clock yesterday morning. They were making some noise when Dr. Baynon, of New Orleans, a guest at the hotel, requested them to make less noise and allow him to sleep. This seems to have angered the two, who followed Baynon to his room and gave him a severe beating, in the midst of which Baynon drew a revolver and fired on them. One ball left a mark along McKean's head, and the other two took effect on McKean's wrist and shoulder. The latter is in a very critical condition, and it is feared he will die.
