C. P. R. Trainmen Get Pay Boost

MONTREAL (CP)—Eight thousand CPR trainmen have been awarded an immediate seven-per-cent increase in a 26-month contract signed by the CPR and the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen.

The agreement also provides for a five-per-cent increase on June 1, 1957. The immediate wage boost is retroactive to April 1, 1957.

The CPR and the brotherhood have already announced an identical agreement covering 10,000 trainmen.

The new contract is based on the unanimous report of a federal conciliation board and includes "graduated rates for trainmen in sending 80 cars in length, six statutory holidays with pay for trainmen in yard service, and other changes in contract provisions."

The increase includes a monthly sum of \$4.25 per employee in lieu of health and welfare benefits.
