Opening lead—jack of clubs. Running a long suit when you are the declarer frequently proves embarrassing to the defense.

First, there is the chance that one defender or the other, not knowing your exact hand, will make a mistake in discarding; second, there is the chance that one defender or the other will find it impossible to discard safely because he cannot guard every suit that needs to be guarded.

For example, take this deal where you open with a preemptive bid of five diamonds which East doubles.

West leads a club and, of course, you ruff. On the bidding,
