TORONTO, (CP)—The stock market dipped sharply Monday. Base metals reached their lowest point since late 1950 and Western oils reached their lowest point this year. Golds continued lower. Uranium were weak during the session but recovered in the final hour. Bonville traded more than 600,000 shares to gain 11 cents at 58 cents. New Brunswick base metals also recovered. Brunswick added \$1 and Keybovcon gained six cents in a turnover of 131,000 shares.

In Western oils Husky, Western Leaseholds, Anglo-Canadian and Canadian Atlantic traded lower. Sweet Grass, New British and Canada Oil Leads gained. Higher-priced base metals slipped and others followed as Cons. Smelters, Falconbridge, Campbell Chibougama and East Sullivan traded lower. Dominion Asbestos and pennies gained some support at the close but continued weak while juniors slipped further. Probers, Prospectors Airways and Ventures lost.
