## THE CANADIAN RAILWAY CHARTERS

OTTAWA, April 20.—The return in Commons shows that in the past two years exclusive of the Charters granted to the Canadian Pacific, Grand Trunk, Grand Trunk Pacific and Canadian Northern, 230 Charters have been granted to Railway Companies authorizing an aggregate construction of 63,809 miles. Of the total number incorporated only 25 have constructed any portion of the Railways authorized and so 50 charters have lapsed. 88 charters have been given one extension of time, 42 have received three extensions. Duties formerly performed by Commissioner of Lights, Fraser, recently dismissed, are to be performed by J. C. McPhail, Engineer in Lights Branch of the Marine Department.

## NOVA SCOTIA ESTIMATES

HALIFAX, April 20.—The provincial estimates have been brought down in the Legislature. Receipts estimated \$1,643,944 and the expenditure at \$1,634,004. Royalty from mines is expected to yield \$615,000, succession duties \$7,000; subsidies \$610,464; interest on Southwestern Railway \$152,730. The chief items of expenditure are Education \$316,000; Public Charities \$212,250; Roads \$175,000; N. S. Technical College \$35,000; Agriculture \$65,000.

## SULTAN HAS ABDICATED

CONSTANTINOPLE, April 20.—The most important feature of the situation in the Turkish capital was the report that the Sultan had abdicated. It caused the greatest excitement throughout the City. The rumor of the flight of the Sultan on a warship followed closely, but neither could be confirmed. The Turkish Foreign Office gave denial to all rumors. Abdication, however, appears not improbable and it is believed that within a day or two the constitutionalists may accept as a successor, Prince Yusoff Izzedin, eldest son of the late Sultan. They are displeased with Abdul Hamid's attitude.

## WOMAN PLOTS AGAINST AMEER

ALLAHABAD, April 19.—The plot against the Ameer of Afghanistan, recently reported, has been definitely traced to the instigation of the Bibi Halima, wife of the late Ameer Abdurrahman, the object being to place her son, Sardar Umar Jan, on the throne. The original plan, which was to poison the Ameer, fell through. Two of the ringleaders were blown from guns on March 11, and other executions have taken place at Jelalabad.
