**Morale Is Low In Hungarian Refugee Camps**

PEMBROKE, Ont. (CP)—J. A. Conroy, who has just returned after 3 1/2 months as a Canadian Red Cross representative in Austrian camps for Hungarian refugees, says Canada's immigration policy should include a determined orientation program.

This should be conducted in the refugee camps, says Mr. Conroy, who for 10 years has been recreation director at Deep River, Ont., site of a large research establishment connected with the atomic energy development at nearby Chalk River.

He said in an interview that many of the Hungarian refugees who came to Canada were "opinionists" who saw the handwriting on the wall. Many of the true patriots were still in Europe's refugee camps and could not understand why.

"It's a hotbed of resentment," he said.

These Hungarians, facing a bleak winter in the camps, "don't need basketballs or baseballs but a directed program designed to help them regain their pride."

"Unfortunately," he said, "the 40 Red Cross teams have no common philosophy for rebuilding broken morale." Each team had its own ideas of what should be done, and lack of over-all planning by the League of Red Cross Societies "has resulted in failure to maintain a constant standard in the work of morale building."

Mr. Conroy, who was stationed in camps on the Austrian-Italian border and in upper Austria, said the refugees should have been equipped with a thorough knowledge of citizenship "before being thrust into a new Western world."

"We have a moral responsibility to meet when we take them into our country. Otherwise they are not only easy targets for unscrupulous employers but also easy meat for Communist organizers."

Canada could not afford to lose the opportunity of assimilating a people able to contribute a storehouse of knowledge to Canada's cultural progress.

It had been a difficult experience, he said, "to live among people who just wait and wait for the door to open a little to let them through."
