MONTREAL, June 21 (CP)—Butter and cheese prices climbed fractionally in brisk trading on the Canadian commodity exchange today while egg offerings held steady.

MONTREAL, June 21 (CP)—Potato, butter, cheese and egg prices firmed on open produce markets here today, the Dominion Department of Agriculture reported.

Creamery butter prints to retailers sold for 22 3-4-23 cents a pound and sold for 22 1-4-23 cents a pound delivered in Montreal was quoted. Quebec No. 1 pasteurized in wholesale jobbing lots made 22.

Ontario white cheese was offered at 12 7-8 for a pound and colored at 13. Quebec white traded for 12 5-8 and colored for 12 3-4.

Graded egg shipments in used free cases were offered at 20 1-2-21 cents a dozen for A-large, 18-18 1-2 for A-medium, 16-17 for B-large, 14-14 1-2 for C.

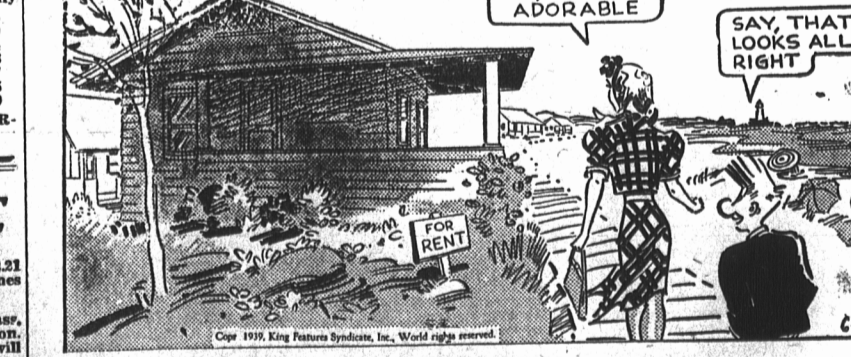
