DUTCH APPLE TART A LA ROTTERDAM HILTON (9") rich flaky butter-pastry shell or use frozen puff pastry

1 cup fine dry bread crumbs
1/2 cup sliced peeled apples
1 cup sugar
1 1/2 cup small moist raisins
1/4 cup chopped blanched almonds
2 tsp butter
1 1/2 cup sifted sliced almonds
14 maraschino or candied cherries
1 cup heavy cream, whipped
Roll pastry scant 1/4" thick. Fill into 9" round layer cake pans instead of pie plate. Dust with crumbs; press in.

In hot oven at 375 degrees, 30 minutes. Turn out on a greased platter. Top with 1" strips of pastry rolled from trimmings. Bake 10 min. at 450 degrees. Continue to bake 35 min. at 375 degrees.
