Local and Other Items.

HOW THE LETTERS GO.—Sir Richard Cartwright announced in the House of Commons recently that any Canadian letters destined for Great Britain posted later than Wednesday in any week are forwarded by Canadian steamships unless endorsed "via New York." The New York route is from two to three days faster at present.

In a Florentine musical paper, La Scena Illustrata, Mascagni tells the story of a visit which he paid to Verdi with his wife and children. Verdi was installed in his favorite suit of rooms at the Hotel Milano. He loves children, and before long he had the bimbi perched upon his knee. Mascagni had come to Milan to conduct some orchestral concerts at La Scala, and he had a great deal to say about his programmes and his novelties.

The old man listened with interest to his descriptions of works by Scandinavian and Slavonic composers, which are rarely heard in Italy, particularly those of Svendsen and Tschaiikowsky. After a time Mascagni heard him murmur, as if talking to himself, "Who would have thought in my time that people like that would know how to compose music?"

An American Claim.
WASH NGTON, July 29—R. Brown, who claims to be a citizen of the United States, has filed with the State Department a claim for \$2,000,000 against the Transvaal. He alleges that he had mining interests in that country which he lost because justice was denied him in the courts. He asserts that the court was originally favourable to him, but that Kruger removed the Chief Justice because of a disposition to favour him. The matter will be investigated.

It is bounded by Cannon, DeKalb, Coffee, Grundy, Van Buren, and White counties and is in no way remarkable except in shape.—St. Louis Republic.
