

Brave Girls Baffle a Burglar.

ONE CHOP OFF TWO OF HIS FINGERS AS HE TRIES TO ENTER A WINDOW. Two girls frustrated a burglary of a few nights ago at the house of Colonel Daniel Franklin, a retired merchant of Glen Falls, Conn., a thriving factory village four miles north of Plainfield, Col.
