

**Ceylon Faces Money Problem**

COLOMBO (AP)—After years of good living, Ceylon is running out of money.  
This island nation off India today imports more than its exports. The government spends more than it collects in taxes. Its foreign exchange reserves are almost depleted.  
Fear of repercussions from angry voters has prevented the government from carrying out its own calls for austerity. Most opposing politicians also shy away from the unpopular measures that Ceylonese economists and foreign experts say are necessary.  
"The trouble is," a leading opposition politician said, "we have been supporting a Rolls-Royce welfare state on a lull-back cart economy."
