U. S. Steel

CLEVELAND, (AP) — Some sellers of premium-priced steel plates are having to look for customers, indicating further movement toward supply and demand balance, Steel magazine says. Noting that dealers in high-priced steel always are the first to feel a decline in demand, the magazine adds: "While freight car builders are renewing pressure for steel plates they are shunning conversion material. They want plates, but they don't feel the situation warrants paying the high price of conversion steel." Galvanized sheets, extremely tight just a few months ago, also are being ordered with less zeal, the weekly report says. As the domestic supply-demand picture improves, Steel says additional foreign iron and steel is being offered for sale in the United States.

Bull Market Fervor Boosts New York Stocks

NEW YORK, (AP)—Bull market fervor boosted stocks last week. The rally all but wiped out the slump that halted the Eisenhower election boom. Railroads were prominent in the move. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks advanced \$1.70, the best showing in two months. At the end of the week it stood at \$115.70, a net loss of only 10 cents on the net, less than the average now stands only slightly below the 1952-53 peak reached Jan. 5 when it was at \$116.30.

The market had a habit of anticipating bad news and capitalizing on good news. United States Steel reported a drop of 22 per cent in net income last year from the previous year and Bethlehem Steel reported a 15 per cent fall—because of the costly steel strike in 1952. Bethlehem rushed ahead when it became apparent that it had done better than expected. When Southern Railway proposed a two-for-one split and raised its dividend, the resultant rush to buy put the stock up six points. The daily average in New York amounted to 1,641,000 shares. The previous week it was only 1,373,000 shares.

Canadian issues were mixed. Canadian Pacific was up 1-4; Disasters Seagram and International

Nickel were both unchanged. McIntyre dropped 3-4. Hiram Walker was off 1-8 and Dome Mines slipped 1-4. On the American stock exchange Royalite Oil added 1-8, Giant Yellowknife was up 1-4 and Lake Shore was down 1-8.

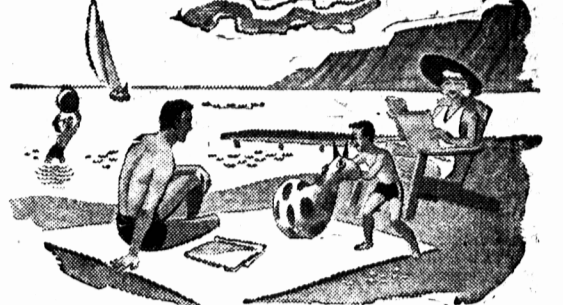
