Notice to Commercial Travellers. The attention of Commercial Travellers is called to the following Act of the Legislature of the Province of Prince Edward Island, Session 1894, entitled "An Act to impose a Direct Tax on Certain Classes of Traders."

1. From and after the passing of this Act every casual trader not permanently residing in this Province, commonly known as "Commercial Travellers," and every person not permanently residing in this Province, who sells either for himself or any other person any goods, wares or merchandise, or canvasses for or solicits or canvasses for orders either for himself or any other person for the purchase or change or purchase of any goods, wares or merchandise within this Province, either by the production of samples, photographs, catalogues, logues, printed or written matter, or simply by word of mouth without the production of samples, photographs, catalogues, printed or written matter, shall, before he or she enters upon the business of so selling any goods, wares or merchandise, or for the purchase or change or purchase of any goods, wares or merchandise for such orders, pay to the Provincial Treasurer of this Province an annual license fee of direct tax, the said Provincial Treasurer shall grant a license authorizing the person therein named to so sell, or to canvass for or purchase of goods, wares and merchandise in this Province, such license shall be granted and remain in force for the space of one year following the date upon which the said license shall be granted and no longer.

2. Upon payment of the said license fee of direct tax, the said Provincial Treasurer shall grant a license authorizing the person therein named to so sell, or to canvass for or purchase of goods, wares and merchandise in this Province, such license shall be granted and remain in force for the space of one year following the date upon which the said license shall be granted and no longer.

3. Any such Commercial Traveller or person who is not permanently residing in this Province as aforesaid, who, after the passing of this Act, shall sell, or canvass for or purchase of any goods, wares or merchandise, or solicit or canvass for orders for the purchase or change or purchase of any goods, wares or merchandise as aforesaid, shall be liable to pay to the Provincial Treasurer of this Province a fine of not more than one hundred dollars, or to the said Provincial Treasurer.

This Act is now in force. Licenses can be procured in Charlottetown at the Provincial Treasury, in Summerside from Wm. T. Hunt Esq., in Georgetown from George B. Aitken Esq.
