### IDA BAILEY ALLEN Food Experts Call Lamb Tender, Satisfying Meat

LAMB is a popular meat in California and throughout New York and New England. In other parts of the country, less lamb is used. Some people have never tasted lamb, yet say they don't like it.

Tender And Versatile  
However, lamb is one of the most tender, versatile and satisfying meats, as every part is just as usable as corresponding parts of other meats sold in our markets.

At the lamb-cutting demonstration held for food editors at the Four Seasons Restaurant in New York City, we learned that with most of the fat removed, the 3 1/2 lb. (cooked weight) carcasses for an arm lamb chop are only 225; for a loin chop, only 195; for a loin chop, only 225 calories of meat, all cuts naturally tender.

- Mayonnaise Cream Sauce (recipe follows)
- 6 large, fresh mushroom crowns
- 1 tsp. salad oil
- 12 parboiled cooked small potatoes
- 13 cooked tiny carrots
- 6 sprigs fresh mint
- Rub chops all over with salt and pepper (and 1-16 tsp. powdered onion, if desired). Brush all over with melted butter.
- Place chops 1" apart in 7" x 11" baking pan. Roast 45 min. in mod. oven, 350 degrees F., or until fork is tender and browned on both sides. Remove from oven.
- Spread each chop generously with Mayonnaise Cream Sauce; top with a fresh mushroom crown brushed with oil. Brown under broiler. Arrange smartly on large oblong platter. Border with vegetables; garnish with mint.
- Mayonnaise Cream sauce: With a fork, stir 1 tsp. lemon juice into 1/2 c. mayonnaise. Fold in 2 tsp. whipped cream.
- THE CHIEF LIKES  
Barbecued Riblets of lamb: Order 2 lb. lamb riblets, separated to serve singly. Brush generously with barbecue sauce of choice. Cover. Refrigerate 3 hrs. to season.
- Arrange 1" apart in baking pan. Melt and pour over 3 tsp. butter. Bake 15 min. in hot oven, 400 degrees F. Reduce heat to 350 degrees F. Reduce heat to more. Baste twice with additional barbecue sauce. The riblets should be well-browned. Cool 5 min.; slip a paper ruffle on end of each.

6 double loin lamb chops  
1 1/2 tsp. salt  
3/4 tsp. pepper  
melted

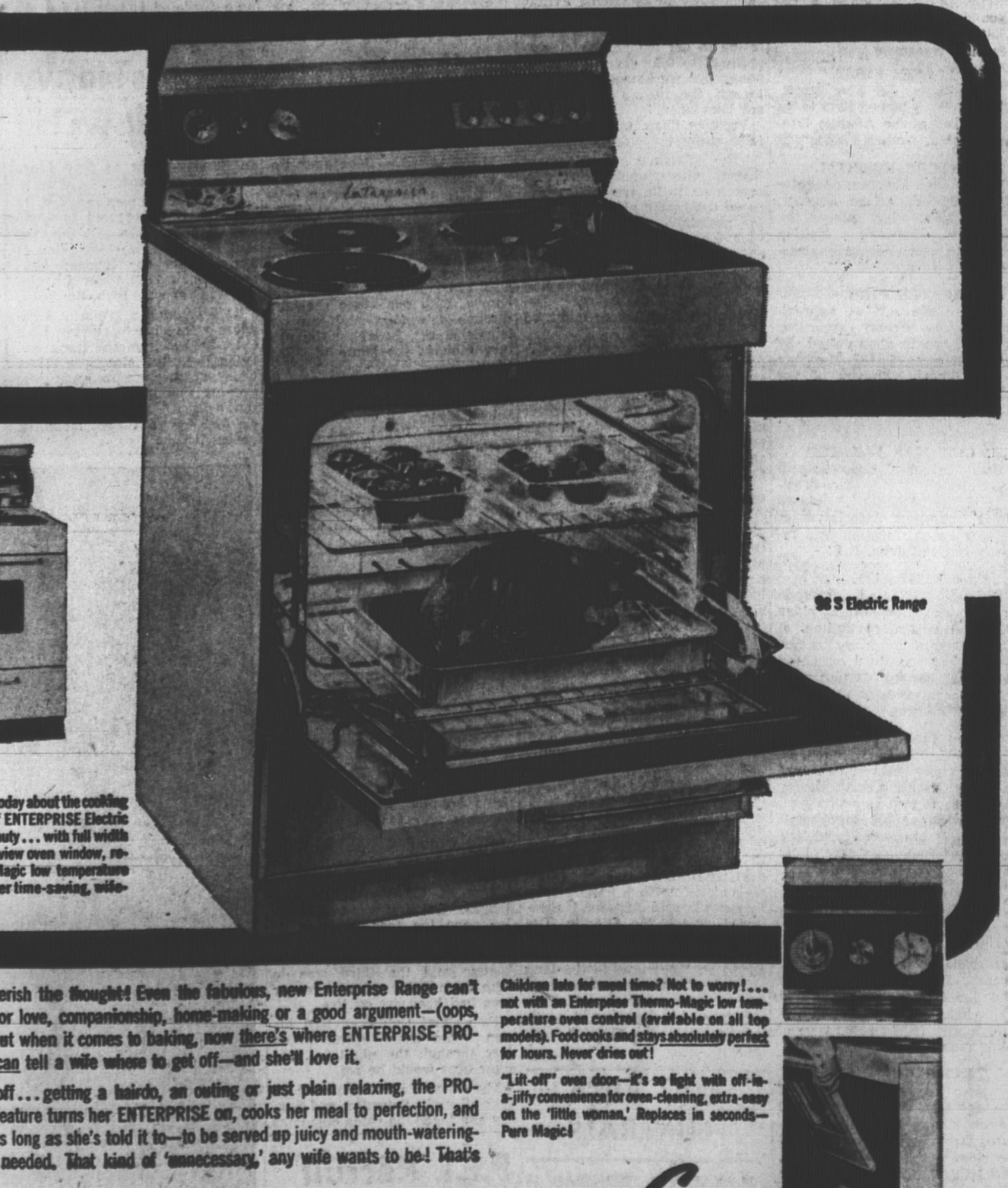
