LONDON (CP) — Visitors to Britain in the first four months of the year reached 247,000, a seven-per-cent increase over last year.

Steamship Seized For \$7,500,000

BALTIMORE (AP) — A U.S. marshal has seized a steamship in drydock here and is holding it pending the outcome of a \$7,500,000 suit against its owner, a Cuban development bank.

The vessel, the Ciudad de la Habana, was attached by U.S. marshal Gerald F. Bracken on June 22 after the suit was filed in U.S. District Court. The ship was formerly owned by Canadian National Steamships under the name Canadian Challenger.

The admiralty action was brought by Flota Maritima Browning de Cuba, Sociadad Anonima, a shipping corporation with offices in Havana and Detroit. It was filed against Banco Cubano del Comercio Exterior, described in the suit as an autonomous credit institution.

Judge Roszel C. Thomsen has given the bank until Aug. 20 to file its answer.

INVOLES IT VESSELS

The Browning firm claimed in its suit that the Cuban bank entered two lease - purchase contracts involving 17 vessels and failed to fulfill the agreements.

Lawyers for Browning said the first contract was executed May 3, 1956, and called for Browning to lease, with an option to buy, six vessels being built for the credit firm in England and Japan.

The suit said the steamship Pinar del Rio was delivered in October, 1956. But it claimed the Cuban firm "wrongfully retook possession" three months later and has failed to redeliver it and perform other obligations under the contract.

ASKING FOR \$7,500,000

Browning is seeking \$1,000,000 damages for this alleged breach of contract.

The shipping firm is asking \$3,500,000 more on a claim that the credit firm breached another lease-purchase agreement involving 11 ships, eight of which have recently been purchased from CNS.

The Ciudad de la Habana was one of these. It is a combination cargo and passenger ship.

The suit said the Ciudad de la Habana and three other vessels were delivered to Browning shortly after the second contract was made, but it contends that the owners breached the agreement.
