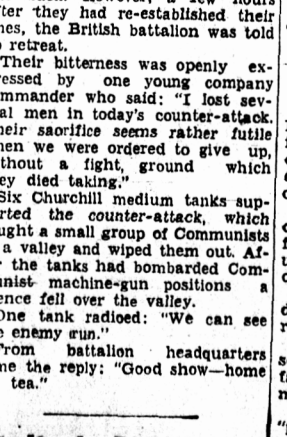
Smoke Causes Difficulty
