MOVES TO BAHAMAS
MONTREAL (CP) - Kingston-born Captain Peter C. Fair, former trans-Atlantic pilot for British Overseas Airways Corporation, has been appointed general manager of Bahamas Airways, Ltd., it was announced Monday. Captain Fair made 400 Atlantic crossings, one of which was a royal flight carrying Princess Margaret to the Bahamas in February, 1955.

PLANE HITS CROWD
BOGOTA, Columbia (Reuters) - Four persons were killed and four children were injured when a crowd rushed into the path of a light plane taking off from an airfield near Manizales, east Colombia, Sunday. The plane swept into the crowd but rose safely and landed five minutes later at a nearby commercial airport.

MONTREAL (CP) - The Royal Ontario Museum said Monday it has uncovered the "most important bird-life discovery in Ontario in at least two decades" and added to evidence that southern birds are moving north into Canada. The find was the interbreeding of two related but different birds—the blue-winged warbler and the golden-winged warbler.

They were found and photographed with four young, nesting at Milton, 30 miles west of Toronto, by a joint museum-Audubon Society team headed by James Basilie of the museum staff. The blue and golden-winged warblers sometimes breed together several hundred miles south of Toronto, but this is the first that the two species have been found nesting together in this country.

The young, incidentally, won't look like either parent and will be known as Brewster-type hybrids.
