

## Second Shipping Year Said Need For Accurate Picture

MONTREAL (CP) — Two men vitally concerned with the building of the St. Lawrence Seaway Tuesday talked of its future.

Transport Minister George Hees and former transport minister Lionel Chevrier, onetime president of Canada's St. Lawrence Seaway Authority, were interviewed before sailing from Montreal on the Empress of France for European "business and holiday" trips.

Both men said an accurate picture of the seaway could only be made after another shipping season had passed.

Mr. Chevrier said a great improvement will come with the disappearance of the old type canalliers U small freighters of the old Lachine Canal era—leaving the system free for large capacity vessels.

Mr. Hees added he is convinced the seaway will benefit tremendously by the recently announced improvement at the Welland Canal where approach berths will be made longer. This will, he said, speed up traffic and rid shippers of the danger of waiting in long, costly queues.

Montreal would benefit also from the seaway "contrary to what some people at first believed."


Mr. Hees said work to twin the locks at the Welland Canal would be put off "as long as possible."

The reason was that \$150,000,000 would have to be spent and "one can't decide overnight to make such an outlay."

Construction of the - up walls and other improvements will start in November and finish in April. These and other improvements, said Mr. Hees, will help the ca-

nal to handle peak-period traffic. Mr. Hees will represent Canada at the current Edinburgh festival.
