be secondary to sensitivity to organisms present in this chronic infection.

"On November 28, the left submaxillary gland was removed at the General Hospital, Vancouver. Much scar tissue was present, binding the gland down. The large gland was two-thirds of the submax duct. It was necessary to tie off the facial artery and vein in order to fully remove the gland for these vessels bound into the adhesions. The pathological report revealed a specimen of yellowish-white tissue which, on external examination, showed a coarse lobulation and in the depths can be felt an extremely firm area. On section through the structure, there was found to exist a thick fibrous wall, with a hollow, cystic centre lined by distending epithelium and this cyst is filled with a calculus of a yellowish color and measuring 1.8 x 1.3 x 0.9 centimeters. The external surface of the calculus is furrowed, showing and shows a large number of small papillary-like elevations. Microscopic examination showed this tissue to consist chiefly of dense, fibrous connective tissues, very massive in structure with lymphocytes and plasma cells, and showing a track-like structure, probably the duct, lined by highly vascularized inflammatory granulation tissue and in part by both a very thick squamous and a more columnar type of epithelium. There is extensive necrosis and abundant polymorph infiltration, probably at the site where the stone was lodged.

"How would you like to travel under such conditions? Have you ever given yourself a hypo on a train. How would you like to lie wide awake hour after hour listening to the snoring of your fellow passengers and the noisy rocking of the train as it speeds along while you counted sheep and waited for the day to break.

My destination was to be Dilke, a little town not far from Regina, where a cousin of mine lived.

Everybody I knew felt that I might get some relief in the West. I hoped and prayed I would. But I hoped in vain. The two months I spent in Saskatchewan brought me no relief and I surrendered a good set of teeth in orders of my latest doctor. He thought my teeth, though apparently sound, might be the cause of some of my trouble. This didn't help any.

From Dilke I went to Alberta. Why? Because everybody I met and talked with in Saskatchewan advised me to try Alberta's wonderful climate.

"You'll likely get rid of your asthma there," they said. I didn't. In fact I was hospitalized after I'd been there only 10 days.

Then the gland in my throat flamed up again. It was discharging considerable pus and causing me much pain. The doctors at the Wainwright Hospital took some X-rays and collected a smear and then strongly advised me to proceed to Vancouver, for further treatment at the Medical Clinic at 710 Seymour St.

What happened next may be best told by my new doctor who handed me the following report after he'd finished with my case: "To Whom It May Concern:

"Mr. Frank MacArthur was referred to us by Dr. Wallace of the Wainwright Clinic of Alberta with a history of asthma dating back to 1928, for which he has been under almost constant treatment ever since.

"His case history reveals his having been to the Massachusetts General Hospital where a diagnosis of chronic asthma was made.

"He developed a gland in the left side of his neck in 1925, which discharged pus from time to time. The submaxillary was removed in N.Y. in 1939 but a swelling recurred two years later in this area. Since that time, he has a persistent discharge into the mouth and the asthmatic condition failed to react under normal treatments.

"Direct smears taken in Alberta showed a few pus cells, yeast cells, gram negative bacilli, no acid fast bacilli. Cultures revealed several yeast cells.

"We saw Mr. MacArthur at the Medical Clinic November 18, 1946, at which time his asthmatic condition was still present. There was a large submax gland on the left side, and pus could be expressed from the duct. Direct smears from this matter showed numerous gram positive cocci in pairs and small groups as well as minute gram negative bacilli. Cultures revealed non-hemolytic strep, micrococci and a few hemolytic strep. No fungi were found.

"Lipiodal injections of the gland was done. This showed a rather ill-defined duct and no ramifications were illustrated. X-rays taken before the injections showed a large irregular calcified mass in the left side, just in front of, and slightly below the level of the angle of the jaw. It was pear shaped, the base being towards the jaw and the apex away from it, with a short, thick stem. With the past history together with our findings, it is felt that the asthmatic condition could possibly

be secondary to sensitivity to organisms present in this chronic infection.

"On November 28, the left submaxillary gland was removed at the General Hospital, Vancouver. Much scar tissue was present, binding the gland down. The large gland was two-thirds of the submax duct. It was necessary to tie off the facial artery
