Horse Notes

The Halifax race track, well known to many of our local sportsmen, has been cleared sufficiently to permit training a few horses over it. Mr. Frank Adams, the well-known horseman of Halifax has fixed up stables at the track and has six horses in training. One of his assistants is Mr. William McVey of Charlottetown.

Mr. Frank Boutillier, veteran trainer, has settled down at the race track and every day is bringing additions to his training strength. On Thursday he received the good trotter Radiant, owned by Col. J. S. Jenkins of this city. It will be remembered that Mr. Boutillier gave this mare a record last year as a three-year-old of 2:22 3/4. It is understood that Col. Jenkins has received many flattering offers but is holding until he gets his price.

The horse races at Truro on Victoria Day, May 24th, this year promise to be very exciting, particularly the free-for-all, as the Sydney boys are coming up with Our Colonel and Dick C. In addition The Ghost, White Sox, Pucky D 1 and Belle McGregor will start. The race is half-mile heats and should be a hummer.

MUCH TIME WAS LOST IN CANADA

OTTAWA, May 18—The time lost in Canada due to industrial disputes during either March, 1922, or April, 1921.

There were in existence during the month 24 strikes, involving about 17,478 workers with an estimated time loss of 481,135 working days. Ten of these strikes were reported to the Labor Department as having commenced during April, five of which were terminated during the month, leaving nineteen strikes, involving about 17,071 workers, on record at the end of the month.

BOLT STRUCK GASOLINE TANK

BAYONNE, N. J., May 18—A bolt of lightning struck a gasoline tank in the yard of the Tidewater Oil Company yesterday, starting a fire, which was not controlled for five hours and which caused damage estimated at \$500,000. Three tanks were destroyed and a network of pipe lines were burned out.
