

Convict Watchman Of Manslaughter

MONTREAL (CP)—A 44-year-old watchman at a religious-supplies store, today was convicted of manslaughter in connection with the fatal shooting of Scottish seaman David Yeaman May 9.

The jury, which went out Tuesday night, recommended mercy. Mr. Justice Wilfred Lazure said he would pass sentence Oct. 29.

Yeaman, a crewman on the freighter Cairnesk, was killed in Morin's bachelor apartment above the mid-town store following a drinking party. Morin testified that Yeaman had molested him and he shot through fear of bodily injury or death.

Medical testimony showed that Yeaman, 25, from Arbroath, Angus, Scotland, was in an advanced state of intoxication when he was shot. Morin summoned police shortly after the shooting.

The jury, which deliberated overnight, asked for further instructions this morning before delivering its verdict.

Prime Minister Returns To Capital

OTTAWA (CP)—Prime Minister St. Laurent returned to the capital today for a cabinet meeting which started this morning.

Mr. St. Laurent is expected to report to his colleagues on his Montreal talks with Premier Duplessis of Quebec. The two discussed federal-provincial fiscal matters Tuesday.

Finance Minister Harris also is expected to raise the subject of increased Canadian contributions to the Colombo Plan.

Canada's contribution now is \$25-400,000 annually plus technical assistance. Mr. Harris is chairman of the conference of ministers of the 16-member nations of the plan which is meeting here this week. The Colombo Plan is aimed at developing the economies of countries in South and Southeast Asia.

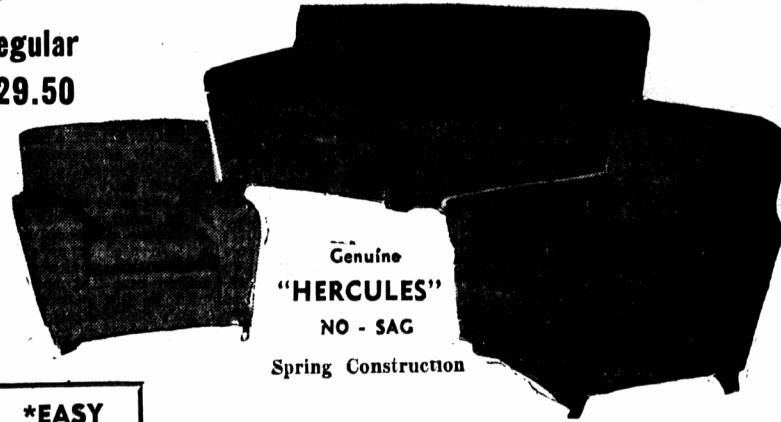
