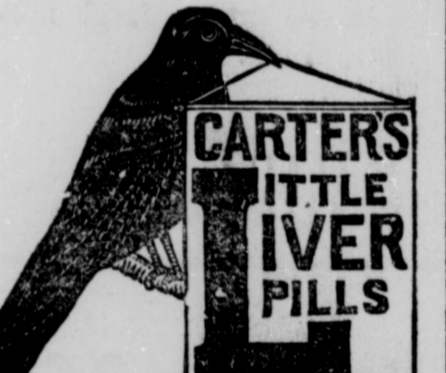
Placing a Poet.
