Churchmen's Summit Talk Is Uncertain

ISTANBUL, Turkey (AP)—Prospects for a meeting between Pope Paul VI and Patriarch Athenagoras of Constantinople—spiritual leaders of 700,000,000 people—remain uncertain.

The Orthodox patriarchate of Constantinople, Istanbul, insisted it was premature to say whether Athenagoras would go to Jerusalem to pray beside the Roman Catholic pontiff during the Pope's Holy Land pilgrimage Jan. 4-8.

Earlier Wednesday Theodosius VI of Antioch, patriarch of the Eastern Orthodox church in Syria, said in Damascus "it has been definitely decided" that Athenagoras should go to Jerusalem for a courtesy meeting with the Pope.

At the Vatican the word from Damascus brought a unofficial comment of satisfaction. L'Osservatore Romano reported the news on page one without comment. This was the first time the Vatican newspaper had mentioned a possible meeting between the religious ruler of 350,000,000 Roman Catholics and Athenagoras, titular leader of the world's 150,000,000 Orthodox.

TRIP 'UP IN AIR'

The Istanbul announcement that Athenagoras' trip was "settled" up in the air came after L'Osservatore had gone to press.

In Damascus, Theodosius withdrew his statement. Athenagoras clearly wants to see the Pope. The Orthodox leader himself proposed a Christian summit meeting during the pontiff's Holy Land pilgrimage.

Pope Paul later indicated a willingness to meet Athenagoras in the Holy Land. The Vatican noted that the Pope had set Christian unity as a goal of the pilgrimage.

AWAITING WORD
A patriarchate spokesman in Istanbul said Athenagoras was withholding a final decision on going to Jerusalem until he had word from other Orthodox churches including those of Alexandria, Antioch, Jerusalem, Greece, Moscow, Belgrade, Budapest, Bucharest, Sofia, Cyprus and Prague.

The spokesman said they were consulted under an agreement for joint decisions reached at a pan-Orthodox conference last September. It was not known here how many of the Orthodox churches have replied.

Most-Wanted List Declines Sharply

OTTAWA (CP)—Canada had just about run out of fugitives from justice with records bad enough to give them the dubious honor of being included in the RCMP's list of most-wanted men.

The list, first issued in 1953 to enlist the aid of the public in the search for wanted men, has dwindled to two, equaling a previous low established in the summer of 1962.

Publicly given the list previously by news media has been responsible for the capture of at least eight wanted men.

The two men still on the list were among the 10 on the original list.

They are William Adams, 36, alias "Sam" Samborski and Joe Lachue, formerly of St. Catharines, Ont., and John Frederick Meagher, 31, formerly of Toronto.

Adams is wanted for the murder of his father in June, 1949, in St. Catharines.

Meagher is wanted by Toronto police for armed robbery with violence and escaping arrest. He escaped from police in April, 1957, while being escorted to Don Jail.

Meagher is considered dangerous and may be armed. The RCMP warns that anyone recognizing him or Adams should not attempt to interfere with them but should call police.

Bank Of N.S. Opens Branch In Scotland

TORONTO (CP)—Banks of Nova Scotia has announced it has opened a branch in Scotland.

The bank said the new branch will provide full banking services, adding it is the first branch to be opened in Scotland by any outside bank.

Shares Removed From Exchange

TORONTO (CP)—Shares of Lynx Yellowknife Gold Mines Ltd., has been removed from the trading list of the stock exchange.

The exchange said in a statement the company had "failed to meet the requirements for maintaining its listing."

The stock had been trading around the six cent mark. High for the year was 12 cents and low for the year five cents. The company has an authorized share capital of 4,000,000 common shares of which 3,710,000 are outstanding.
